What is a cookie?

A cookie is a simple text file sent to your web browser via Outscale websites. They are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites when you visit them.

Why do we use cookies?

Our cookies are used to enhance your user experience, to enable the operation of the websites, to improve their functionality and to provide information to the website editors. We use cookies to ensure the proper functioning of our services and to analyze website navigation.

What cookies do we use?

Here is a list of different types of cookies Outscale uses on its websites:

- Necessary cookies: these cookies are essential to the operation of the site and cannot be deactivated. For example, identification cookies are used to identify the user and avoid him/her having to re-identify on each page.
- Statistical cookies: these cookies allow us to count visits and identify web traffic sources, so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. These may be audience measurement cookies or social network tracking cookies that are used directly by social networks. Social network sharing buttons use cookies to track the navigation of Internet users.

The following list explains which cookies we use and why:
